Community Based Mentoring

Children ages 7 – 14 are enrolled by their parent or legal guardian. The program matches a professionally screened and trained adult volunteer or couple with a child to participate in community activities they both enjoy. Participants commit to meeting 2 – 4 times a month for a minimum of one year. All our matches are supported by professional staff on a regular basis for the length of the relationship.
