WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?

To understand how the healthy brain develops and how specific gene factors influence this development.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

Complete two visits each year for 2-4 years
Provide saliva samples
Complete MEG and MRI scans
Complete neuropsychological and cognitive assessments

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

Children between the ages of 9 and 15 years old, who have never been diagnosed with a psychiatric or neurological disorder, and are medically healthy.
