Recommendation(s): Present proposed changes to student fees for the 2018-2019 school year for consideration and discussion at public hearing in front of the Board of Education. Approval of these proposed changes will be requested at the Board of Education meeting on November 19, 2018.

Purpose: Student Fees were approved by the Board in May of 2018 for the 2018-19 school year. For budgetary reasons, the recommendation is now being made to remove the following reimbursement provision for Westside High School post-secondary education costs:

4. Post-secondary education costs

Advanced Placement (per test) - \$100.00

Board Policy 6340 - Appendix A - 2018-19 Specification of Fees

Westside High School

Westside High School students will not be charged any fees for general school supplies or consumable items. The District will provide all general supply items required for classroom instruction.

The school may ask students or parents to donate consumable items such as facial tissues or other items for general classroom use although no such donation will be required of any student or family, and no student shall receive any advantage or benefit from voluntary participation.

The following items are to be paid, or be provided, by students at Westside High School:

4. Post-secondary education costs

Advanced Placement (per test) - \$100.00

PSAT (per test) - \$25.00

Dual Enrollment (maximum, per course) - \$450.00
